PCV Presents: "Dr. Stonestreet, a 19th Century Rockville Physician" At the February Monthly Meeting Thursday, February 21, 7 – 9 pm Potomac Community Center

Dr. Stonestreet, portrayed by interpretive docent Clarence Hickey, visits with PCV. Dr. Edward Stonestreet was a Rockville physician who practiced medicine for 51 years (1852-1903) and served as a Civil War Surgeon with the U. S. Army. Mr. Hickey, as Dr. Stonestreet, will share the doctor's life and times, medical education, medical practice, and Civil War service and will talk about Civil War medicine and its effects on civilian medical practice. There will be time for questions and answers. Mr. Hickey is a docent with the Montgomery County Historical Society's (MCHS) Stonestreet Museum of 19th Century Medicine in Rockville, Maryland, and a re-enactor with the MCHS Speakers Bureau. This program is free and open to all.
