### **Fire Safety Home Inspections Set for July 18 - 20**

PCV and the Montgomery County Fire Department are offering free fire safety home inspections to PCV members on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, July 18-20. County firemen will check the operation and placement of your home's smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors, and will install the newly required BATTERY-OPERATED smoke detectors having ten year duration sealed batteries IF YOU HAVE PURCHASED THEM AND HAVE THEM ON HAND. One of these is required for each level of your home, including one for each bedroom area. (For hard-wired detectors, you need an electrician.) The firemen will also evaluate your home's safety, exits and emergency plans. The inspection will take about 90 minutes. This service is for PCV members only.
